# Study abroad with FUA at any time of the year.

FUA is a private higher learning institution located in distinct campus facilities in the historic center of Florence and La Spezia in the Cinque Terre area. All courses are taught in the English language, with the exception of Italian language courses. Faculty members are highly qualified and come from diverse international and professional backgrounds. FUA's copyrighted educational model is based on integration and experiential learning.

FUA is the only institution in Italy whose academic divisions actively engage students in the local community thanks to projects in collaboration with its partner institution, The American University of Florence. Students can choose courses from many academic disciplines and their related departments and courses.

# FLORENCE, TUSCANY

### LA SPEZIA IN THE CINQUE TERRE AREA, LIGURIA

The coastal location of FUA's Cinque Terre Riviera Program is in La Spezia, on the border between Tuscany and Liguria. The city offers a dynamic backdrop as a major Italian port featuring both urban and seaside lifestyles, and is a stone's throw from the Tuscan Riviera towns and marble quarries.
